

### English:

Using a Talk for Writing approach, we will use texts to support our creative writing:

Viking Boy, How to Train your Dragon, A Child's Introduction to Norse Mythology and How to be a Viking (story writing, setting descriptions, poetry, character description and non-chronological reports).

We will also explore poetry.

SPaG: Grammar will be ongoing and linked into our learning of texts.

Class 4 will complete Comprehension sessions twice weekly focusing on a variety of fiction and non-fiction texts, including poetry.

### Art and Design Technology:

- Sketching Viking Warriors
- Making Viking shields
- Researching Viking brooches and making our own, using various media
- Creating Viking helmets
- Baking bread using Viking recipes

### ICT:

We will continue to use computers to present work using the ICT suite. We will integrate the iPads into the class to support our learning. We will look at how to be safe online. We will continue learn how to code.

## Class 4- Spring Term

### Science: Fabulous Forces!

In this physics topic, we will work scientifically to investigate Forces. We will plan and carry out investigations, observe and record accurate results, analyse and evaluate our investigations to draw conclusions. We will focus on accuracy and reliability in our investigations, whilst having a fun and hands-on experience!

RE: Why do Christians believe Jesus was the Messiah? Why is the Torah so important to Jewish people?

### Music and French:

In Music this term, the children will be continuing to learn the songs for the Young Voices event and learn to play the ukulele. They will learn how to perform as a group and how to read musical notation.

In French, the children are going to learn about school life and how to go shopping. They will learn how to name items in the classroom and how to order certain items in a supermarket.

### Topic (History and Geography):

We will also find out about the Anglo-Saxon Kings, the Anglo-Saxon Kingdoms and their resistance to the Vikings. Our topic will end at the Battle of Hastings!

### Maths:

In maths, we will continue to work towards developing mastery within; **Fractions, decimals, percentages, measurement and number**.
